# North Island Matamata





In North Island, you'll explore an authentic Maori village, and even watch a traditional *Haka* dance up close! North Island also houses another little society — see for yourself at the Hobbiton Movie Set. And of course, you'll be surrounded by fantastic natural landscapes, thermal pools, and ancient geological wonders at every turn.





# Spot Creepy Crawlies at Ruakuri Cave

Waitomo's largest cave hides many treasures — cheeky glow worms and stunning crystal formations. Keep your eyes peeled on an entertaining walking tour or a water rafting adventure.

**Cost:** ~NZ\$79 for a walking tour and ~NZ\$150 for a water rafting tour

Tour Timings: From 9AM – 4PM based on season



Hike at Marokopa Falls

This 35m waterfall flows all year round, with raw, majestic power. Take a quick hike around the area for closer views!






# Explore Wal-O-Tapu Thermal Wonderland


See collapsed craters and multicoloured pools at New Zealand's most colourful and diverse geothermal attraction.




# Immerse in Culture at the Mitai Maori Village






Gaze Out at Lake Pukaki

With three routes that are all under an hour, this track offers great views of the Tasman Glacier Lake.





Opening hours: 24hrs; best seen on a clear day


# Soak in the Franz Joseph Glacier Hot Pools

# Heli-Hike at Fox Glacier

Fly in a helicopter to the magnificent Fox Glacier, before experiencing a guided walk on the icy floor. As the heli-hike is dependent on good weather, pick the first flight of the day, so your flight can get bumped to a later session if needed.
